McDonald Transit Associates and RDMT rebranded under parent company, RATP Dev North America

The brand consolidation will benefit current bus, paratransit, rail, and streetcar riders while continuing to experience the same high-quality services they have come to expect.

"Our clients will easily be able to identify RATP Dev by a single name in all of our operational locations across North America.
